Who can use the discount program?



All Utah residents who have a prescription or a standing prescription drug order for an epinephrine auto injector and are not covered by PEHP through the State plan. The program is

primarily designed to help individuals who do not have health insurance or are covered with a large deductible requiring them to cover a significant portion of their epinephrine autoinjector costs.

How does the discount program work?



Eligible participants can complete an application at www.utahepi.net to receive an ID card.

Show this card to the pharmacist at your local pharmacy along with your current prescription

and ask them for the Epinephrine Auto-Injector discount rate.

What brands of epinephrine auto-injector are available?



Discounted EpiPen is available. You will pay the after-rebate discount price (NOT the list price). If you use a different brand of epinephrine autoinjector and want to use the savings program,

talk to your doctor or pharmacist about switching to EpiPen. If changing isn't for you, the program will not lower your costs.

Can I use the savings program with my insurance?



Your insurer may allow payment or reimbursement of the amounts you spend through the Epinephrine Auto-Injector Savings Program. If your insurer allows electronic payment, ask your pharmacist to process the

discounted price as a "Secondary Claim" to your regular insurance. If your insurer does not allow electronic processing, keep your pharmacy receipts and ask your insurer for a direct claim form or reimbursement form. Complete the form using the information on the pharmacy receipts (e.g. date of service, NDC number, quantity, cost, etc.) and submit the form to your insurer for reimbursement.

How much will I pay?
